A FAMILY CHAMPAGNE HOUSE

The principles of the Grose family, at Thurlestone Hotel, are shared by the Gremillets - creativity, originality and determination which come together to provide an especially enjoyable and high quality experience, with undoubted integrity.

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The Gremillet's 48 hectare estate is located in Balnot sur Laignes (45 km from Champagne's historic capital Troyes) and next to Les Riceys, the largest champagne-growing commune, famous for its high quality Pinot Noir. The majority of their vines are planted in an area called the Côte des Bars, on Pinot Noir-friendly limestone soils, interspersed with clayey marls. This an exceptional terroir where the steep and sun-drenched slopes reveal all the power and fruitiness of the Pinot Noir. The rest of the vines are Chardonnay adding finesse and freshness.

The two Cabernets (Sauvignon and Franc) often like to partner with Merlot to add finesse and fragrance. These are great partners with a wide range of meats.
