TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- This offer is only available for Thurlestone Hotel Residents
- If any non-hotel residents are to join, they must pay the golf course directly at the appropriate green fee price
- Golf bookings can only be made once a confirmed hotel reservation is made covering the dates requested
- One round of complimentary golf is available per resident per day, this includes the day of arrival but not departure days
- All tee times for Thurlestone Golf Club must be booked via the Thurlestone Hotel reception
- All tee times must be booked in advance and are subject to availability
- No tee times are available before 11am daily
- Tee times can be booked up to six months in advance
- A handicap certificate or proof of membership at a Golf Club must be provided to the golf club prior to starting your round
- The golf clubs dress code must be followed; details are listed on the 2nd page
- Any cancellations or amendments must be made via Thurlestone Hotel Reception, 14 days prior to date of play. A late cancellation or no-show charge of £20 may be applied.
- Buggy and equipment hire bookings are not included and must be made with and paid for with the Golf Club directly
- A voucher must be obtained from the hotel reception and presented to the golf club on arrival for this offer to be redeemed
- If you park in the golf clubs car park you must input your car registration number in to the readers in the club house to ensure you are not charged for parking
- Thurlestone Hotel will accept no responsibility for parking tickets issued in the golf clubs car parks
- The decision to suspend play on the course, due to, for example, weather conditions is the decision of Thurlestone Golf Club
- No monetary alternative is available for this offer, even in the event that play is suspended

Thurlestone Golf Club Dress Code

On the Course

An acceptable standard of golfing attire should be maintained on the course at all times.

- Golf Shoes must be worn
- No blue denim, combat type trousers, cargo shorts or tracksuits are permitted
- No rugby or football or tee shirts are permitted
- Smart tailored shorts or golf skirts of a presentable length may be worn with appropriate or predominately white sports socks.
- Gentlemen's shirts are to be kept tucked into trousers or shorts
- Caps/Hats to be worn the right way round
- Mobile telephones may be used on the course for medical emergencies

In the Clubhouse

All members, temporary members and guests are expected to wear a reasonable standard of dress in the Clubhouse at all times.

- Appropriate clothing worn on the course or tennis courts may be worn in the clubhouse
- No Beachwear
- Appropriate foot wear must be worn at all times
